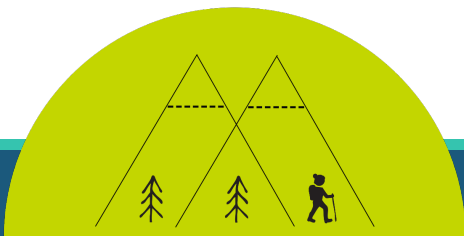

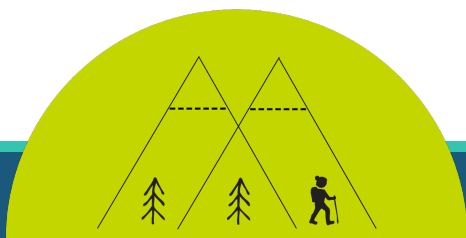

Rooms have been booked for delegates at the Gold Rush Inn.

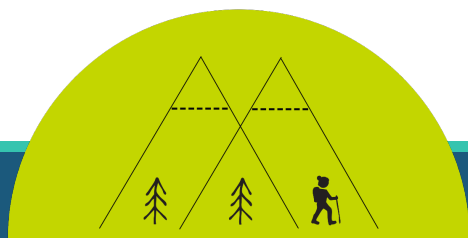
6:00 pm Dinner

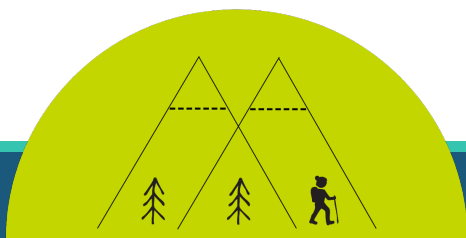
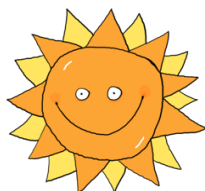
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9:30 am Welcome & Introductions

Lunch will be provided by La Cara Catering at the Linda Rapp Building.

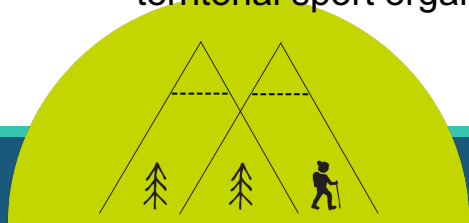
1:00 pm Keynote and Workshop

9:00 am Arrive

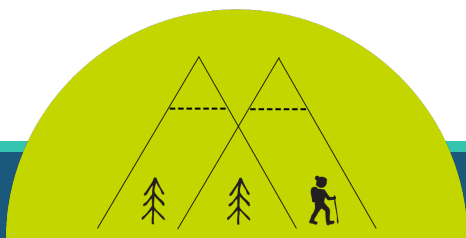
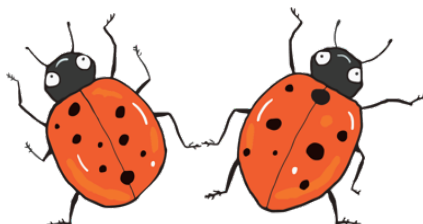
Participants will gather at the Linda Rapp Building. Breakfast will be on your own prior to the start of the event, however coffee and snacks will be provided throughout the morning sessions.

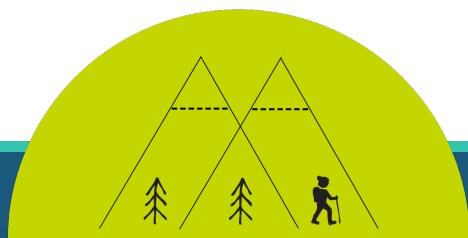
12:00 pm Lunch

3:00 pm Lumel Studios Glass Blowing

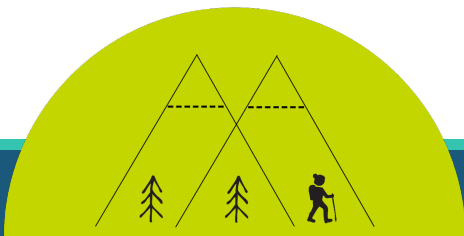
End the day with a hands-on glass blowing workshop with Lumel Studios! Get creative, and enjoy a fun afternoon activity to wrap up the day together.
