

How many volunteers do I have to provide?

Each participating club is required to provide one volunteer slot for every three athletes registered, with the total number of slots always rounded up to the nearest multiple of three. For example, a club with 1 to 3 athletes would provide 1 volunteer slot, 4 to 6 athletes would require 2 slots, 7 to 9 athletes would require 3 slots, and so on.

Does my club have to provide volunteers?

Yes, there is no payout or alternative support method available. For the competition to be able to run, we need the support of clubs in this capacity.

How long is a volunteer slot?

Each slot is one session long. These sessions vary in time commitments, but average between 3 to 4 hours.

Who can volunteer?

Anyone associated with your club who meets the age requirements for that volunteer position. Some positions do have specific age requirements, which will be clearly noted in the position sign-up title. Family members, athletes, staff, and community members are all welcome to participate.

Are background checks required?

All volunteers aged 18 and over are required to have a background check completed within the past three years. We accept any valid background check, or a new check may be completed through a local police service or [Sterling Background Check](#) services.

How do I submit my background check?

To submit your background check, please send it to support@abgym.ab.ca. If you are completing your check through the Sterling Background Check link above, your results will be shared directly with AGF.

Will AGF provide a volunteer letter for my my backcheck?

Yes. If you require a volunteer letter, please email support@abgym.ab.ca with your full name and email address, and we will provide one for you.

Do we have to volunteer within our discipline?

Volunteer slots can be fulfilled in any position or discipline visible on the sign up.

Does my volunteer need to buy a spectator ticket?

No, volunteers are given free entrance for that day.

How do I know if my volunteers responsibilities are filled?

AGF will be in communication after the final deadline to confirm how many spots each club has signed up for.

What should I tell my parents?

Once the schedule is more defined, we will provide clubs with a templated email that will include all volunteer sign-up information and instructions. Clubs can then share those details directly with their families.
